Australia will once again have a strong presence at this year's World Youth, Student and Educational Travel Conference (WYSTC) in Belgrade Serbia, 20-23 September.

The self-branded 'Team Australia' contingent will be made up of 22 delegates from 18 Seller companies. The majority are from New South Wales (10), with Queensland, Northern Territory and Australia-wide making up the balance.
