TAFE QUEENSLAND TO USE WEBSITE TRAVEL FOR TRAINING

Students at TAFE Queensland are set to use new technology, Website Travel, in 2018 for travel, tourism and hospitality studies, which will assist them once transitioned into the competitive workforce.
